# ART | BA

The BA in Art allows students to focus on studio art but in a more flexible and less studio-rigorous fashion than the BFA degree options. The BA in Art encourages students to consider a double major or dual-degree, minors, or certificates in specific art or non-art related disciplines, and/or complete preprofessional requirements for other non-art related programs.

Many students graduating with a BA in Art go on to pursue professional programs in healthcare (medical school, veterinary school, art therapy graduate programs, etc.) and other graduate programs in both non-art and art-related disciplines (i.e., law, business, counseling, etc.).
